## **Dates to Remember**

**July 1** – Assessment fee due (Don't forget! If the fee is not paid by 30 days after the due date, there is a \$40 late charge.)

July 4 -- Independence Day

**July 20** -- Street Sweeping (please try to avoid parking on the streets)

#### August 14 – Bulk Trash Pickup

Per State law, placement cannot begin until 9 days before the scheduled pickup week which begins Mon., Aug. 14. Homeowners need to put their bulk trash out at least by Sunday, the 13th, to ensure pickup. For more information go online at https://www.phoenix.gov/publicworks/garbage/bulk trash.

#### **Homeowner Reminders:**

### Trash pick up

Per Legacy Villas rules trash is not to be put out before 6 PM on Monday and containers need to be behind gates by noon on the following Wednesday. Containers are to be at least 4 ft. apart and placed on the street, not the sidewalk per city of Phoenix guidelines. Plastic bags with or without trash are not to be placed in the recycling containers.

#### **Pocket Gophers, Roof Rats, and Squirrels**

Our development has numerous rodent visitors this year. The board is advising residents to rid their properties of any leftover fruit on trees or on the ground since this seems to attract these unwanted visitors. Several residents have hired pest control companies to remove rodents from their attics. A coyote was also recently spotted in the community so be careful walking at night and with small pets.

#### **Pool Maintenance**

Backwash or draining from a pool is not allowed to flow out onto the Legacy Villas common area or into the street. This is a violation of both the "Legacy Villas Rules Procedures and Design Guidelines: Other Regulations" document as well as Phoenix City Code and homeowners can be fined by both.
