Board of Directors

The Annual Meeting of the Legacy Villas Homeowners Association was held at Deer Valley Community Center on November 16, 2022. Fifteen residents representing 11 units were in attendance. Six units voted with mail-in or email ballots.

Board members reported on various projects during the year including the Rental Unit/RVParking Survey and Tree Trimming/Loss. Treasurer Lori Verreault provided an update on the 2022 budget. The proposed budget for 2023 was presented and approved. There is an increase in the budget for the first time in 10 years due to two large projects (road resurfacing and wash reconstruction) anticipated in 2023. This resulted in an increase in the Assessment Fees as well to \$125/quarter (still much lower than in surrounding HOA communities).

Jenifer Lovejoy and Susan Morgan were reelected to the Board of Directors by 17 votes. Carmen Whitesell volunteered at the meeting to run to serve as a member of the Board and was elected with 11 votes cast (difference being the mail in ballots). Remaining Directors are Ace Clark, Ursula Demciuch, Sajesh Enampurath and Lori Verreault.

On December 14, 2022, Jenifer Lovejoy was elected President; Carmen Whitesell, Vice President; and Lori Verreault, Secretary/Treasurer.

Board meetings are tentatively scheduled for the third Wednesday of each month at 7:00 p.m. Agendas will be posted on the Community Bulletin Board in advance of each meeting.

Dates For Your Calendar

Trash Collection:

Regular trash collection on Thursday is not impacted by any holidays during 2023, <u>except for</u> <u>Thanksgiving Day (Friday collection)</u>. Please remove all receptacles from view from the street no later than noon Friday (Saturday in November).

Bulk Trash Collection:

Collection in our area in 2023 begins on:

March 20 September 18

June 19 December 18

City ordinance prohibits placement at the curb more than 9 days before the scheduled collection week.

Street Sweeping:

Street sweeping will be conducted during the day on the following dates:

February 21 August 15 May 16 November 21

Please try not to leave your vehicles on the street on those days.
